Competence and example of assignments

Daniel Olsson is, as an employee at CIT, EnerMa AB, involved in several different projects in relation to different clients.

Daniel works with projects that vary a lot in extent and content depending on the client. A great deal of the work is about evaluation of different methods and systems for recourse- and energy saving measures.

Daniel has, together with two fellow students, in his dissertation project at the department of Building Services at Chalmers Engineering, made a comparison of Swedish and British contemporary office buildings. Cultural differences regarding engineering practice, architecture and purchasing, demands from clients etc. The main point is however on building services engineering and energy consumption.

Two examples of specified assignments

Performance Contracting

A project about performance contracting ordered by an international large enterprise. The assignment is about studying and developing guidelines for performance contracts where the fundamental business idea is to perform and get paid for recourse- and energy saving measurements.

The Swedish Energy Agency

An investigation has been carried out about how an energy certification of different buildings could be performed. Daniels contribution to this project has, among other things, been to study existing national and international environment- and energy certification methods.
